Nocturne Art At Night Society – Director at Large - Vice Chair

Nocturne is a non-profit organization seeking a volunteer to serve as a Director at Large on the Board of Directors.

Nocturne: Art at Night is a fall festival that brings art and energy to the streets of Kijipuktuk/Halifax between 6 p.m. and midnight the week after the October long weekend. The completely free annual event showcases and celebrates the visual arts scene in Mi'kma'ki/Nova Scotia. Nocturne, designed and planned largely by volunteers, is an opportunity for everyone to experience the art of Kijipuktuk/Halifax in a whole new light.

The Director at Large - Vice Chair will be responsible for the following:

- Attendance of monthly evening board meetings and committee meetings
- Meet and liaise with community partners, sponsors, and artists
- Contribute to both short-term and long-term strategic planning
- General support in the management of the event and organization, including acting as a resource for other board members, committee members, and other volunteers as needed
- Undergo additional training, when available to further develop the role
- Help form policies and procedures for the ongoing betterment and growth of Nocturne

Succession planning for Nocturne is a key focus for us and while we look to board members to stay on for a period of two years we like to plan ahead for potential gaps in our leadership before they happen. This Director at Large position will work alongside the chair to manage and chair meetings of the board and general membership as well as assist as needed throughout the organization. If/when our current chair resigns the vice chair would assume the role of interim chair until we can officially vote in a new slate of directors for the coming year at an AGM. Nocturne has a long history of relying on the skills of individuals within their work/daily life to inform the roles they take on the board and are interested in hearing from any candidate that feels their skills would be put to good use by the organization.

Time commitment is 4-5 hours per month with less in the off-season and more about 6-8 weeks leading up to the event. Attendance at the monthly board meeting is a requirement, plus other committee meetings as required.
